ICYMI: Kirsten Engel Joins "Fast Politics" Podcast To Discuss Arizonan Values

TUCSON, AZ — Kirsten Engel – educator, former Arizona state legislator, and mom – joined Molly Jong-Fast on "Fast Politics" to discuss access to reproductive healthcare, the GOP-manufactured chaos in the House of Representatives, and her campaign for Arizona's 6th Congressional District.

On Kirsten's campaign for Congress: "This is a moderate district. Arizonans are down-to-earth, independent-minded folks, and they are not extremists and what we have is an extremist now two spots away from the presidency – two heartbeats away – and that my opponent voted for him is so out of keeping with the priorities of people in this district."

On protecting reproductive healthcare: "People are watching their rights being threatened and taken away. Arizona is looking at the potential return of an 1800s law – passed at the time that Arizona was a territory - hoop skirts and women didn't even have the right to vote - which makes abortion a crime. People are really really upset about this, and they see my opponent going to Congress to strip away their rights over their own bodies by voting for national abortion restrictions."
