DCCC Adds Engel to Red to Blue Program

Engel secures her place as top Democratic recruit in 2024 in key battleground district

TUCSON, AZ — Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee (DCCC) has added Kirsten Engel to their Red to Blue program, highlighting Arizona's 6th congressional district as one of their top flippable targets for the 2024 cycle in the pathway to the majority.

"I am thrilled to lead Arizona's efforts to take back the House in 2024," **said Engel**. "The DCCC is right to focus on southern Arizona, where voters want to end the dysfunction in Congress brought to them by my opponent and the Republican majority and get to work on protecting abortion rights and addressing our water crisis. To receive this status so early shows that we are on the right track to securing the resources we will need to flip this district and giving the residents of Arizona the representation and leadership they deserve."

DCCC Red to Blue joins a growing list of major endorsements for Engel, including leaders such as U.S. Senator Mark Kelly and Congressman Ruben Gallego, and organizations like the New Democrat Coalition Action Fund, EMILYs List, Giffords PAC, and the League of Conservation Voters.
