Tucson, AZ — Republican candidate Juan Ciscomani was <u>caught on camera running</u> <u>away from a question about abortion bans</u>, according to new footage. Democratic congressional candidate for Arizona's 6th District Kirsten Engel released the following statement:

"I am seriously concerned and disturbed that my Republican opponent, Juan Ciscomani, would rather run away than answer questions about abortion. Just like Blake Masters and Kari Lake, Ciscomani proudly supports extreme abortion bans like the near-total 1901 ban that just went into effect in our state, which has no exceptions for rape or incest and criminalizes doctors and women.

"Ciscomani is clearly trying to hide his extremely unpopular views — but Arizona voters deserve to know the truth. If Ciscomani is too cowardly to face voters on the campaign trail, how can we trust him to represent us in Congress?

"In Congress, I will always fight for Arizona's women and girls to have the right to make decisions over their own bodies — not politicians."

Ciscomani cheered the overturning of Roe v. Wade, which gave women the fundamental right to choose. Recently, in an Arizona Daily Star interview, Ciscomani voiced his support for a ban on abortion in Arizona without exceptions for rape or incest.
