Former Congressman Ron Barber Endorses Kirsten Engel

Barber joins growing list working to elect Kirsten Engel

TUCSON, AZ – Former Congressman Ron Barber has endorsed Kirsten Engel in her campaign for the office he once held.

After a career that spanned over thirty years with the Arizona Division of Developmental Disabilities as Regional and State Director, Barber served as District Director for Congresswoman Gabby Giffords from 2007- 2012. Barber was serving in that post on January 8, 2011 when he and eighteen others were shot by a gunman at a constituent outreach event in Tucson. After Giffords' resignation Barber ran for and held the seat from 2012 to 2015.
