Kirsten Engel Running for U.S. Congress AZ-06

After narrowly losing to Republican Juan Ciscomani in last year's midterm elections, Engel looks to finish the job in 2024

TUCSON, AZ – Former State Senator Kirsten Engel is running for the U.S. House of Representatives in Arizona's Sixth Congressional District.

"Each and every day, I talk to Arizonans who are struggling to get by. Let's face it, for so many of us, the American Dream keeps falling further and further out of reach.
